

### **Procedure for filling vacant student places and competition conditions at the Faculty of Medicine**

1. Applications for a vacant student place must be submitted to the dean's office before the beginning of a new semester. A vacant student place is filled within four weeks of the beginning of the semester.
2. To apply for a vacant student place, the person must meet the prior education requirements, must have completed the prerequisite courses specified in the curriculum, and must meet the conditions set out in clauses 96–99 of the Study regulations. In integrated bachelor's and master's curricula, the applicant's weighted average grade across all the results in the relevant curriculum must be at least 2.0. Applicants who have obtained their previous education in another language but wish to apply for a place in an Estonian-taught curriculum must provide proof of Estonian language proficiency at level B2.
3. Applicants are ranked, taking into account the percentage of completion of studies required by the curriculum. All applicants who have completed 100% or more of the required volume of the curriculum are considered equal. If there are equal applicants, the weighted average grade in the curriculum for which they are applying is considered, taking into account positive results.
4. Prior learning and work experience are recognised towards fulfilling the curriculum based on the applicant's request, in accordance with the procedure for the recognition of prior learning and professional experience.
